"What's Your Number?" Is back and has begun!

As a way to help our church at this time, the Hand In Hand Committee will once again be offering the very simple fundraiser we have called "What's Your Number?" This time we have decided to have the funds raised help with

the expenses occurred from the flood damage of the CE Centre in March.

So how does this fundraiser work?

In the Church foyer will be a bulletin board with envelopes numbered 1 to 100. If you would like to contribute to this fundraiser, simply take an envelope off the board and donate the dollar value of that envelope. For example - if you take the number 43 you would donate 43 dollars. Do you have a favourite number and was it chosen by someone else? No problem! Simply take two or more envelopes that add up to that number. For example – you want to donate 25 dollars, but the "25" is already gone ... take envelopes "15 and 10" or envelopes "18 and 7" or whatever else adds up to "25". (We are also adding some extra envelopes to the lower numbers of 1 to 10.) If you would like a tax receipt for your donation, add your KUBC envelope number or your name and address to the front of the envelope. Place your envelope in the special box in the foyer on Sundays or in the Office Drop Safe by the window.

We would be so excited to see if all the dollar amounts for the envelopes would be donated as all the numbers added together would equal \$5050.00!! (the extra envelopes of the lower numbers are not included in this total).
