JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow meander through Mark) Read Mark 10:4-5

Jesus directed his hostile questioners to refer to Moses about the lawfulness of divorce in Jewish life. They responded with Scripture that implied it was permissible. Jesus did not see this law as saying that divorce was the will of God, but that if a divorce happened, it was God's will for the husband not to treat his wife harshly, but to provide her with the legal resources she would need.
