JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow journey through John)

Read John 16:4b-7

Jesus' disciples react to the news of him going to the Father with grief. This shows that they only seem to be able to see it in negative terms, and only in terms of what it will mean for them. What it will mean for Jesus is not understood or appreciated. But now Jesus reveals that they will be better off with him gone and the Spirit present. Such is the greatness of the gift of God's Spirit!
