JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow meander through Mark) Read Mark 3:31-35

Jesus' family arrives to save him from himself. They do not accept Jesus as a man empowered by God any more than his critics do. To them he was delirious, to his critics demonic. But when he was told that his mother and brothers wanted him, he clarified who his true family was: people of other families who did the will of God were his family. That is a kinship far deeper than blood.

From the Board of Stewards - As many of you know, the church approved the roof project for replacing the flat roof over the chapel at a cost of \$59,859 plus HST.

\$15,000 of the funds will come from the memorial fund and up to \$25,000 from the \$77,485 remaining in the unallocated Hiltz funds.
