



The Deacons will be making a print church family directory available for this fall. This will contain names and addresses, emails and telephone numbers. Our desire is to give our church family more ways to reach out to each other, while being careful to respect the need for personal privacy. There will be several steps over a series of weeks:

1. **Request to opt out by June 30** - Before the print directory is available for confirmation of personal information, if you do not want your full information in the directory, please call or email the church office.
2. **Confirm details** - one print copy of the directory will be available in the foyer beginning July 3 for all four Sundays in July. Please check that your name, address, email and telephone number are correct. If correct, please put a check mark by your name. If incorrect, please put an X by your name and the correct details on the page opposite in the binder provided. If you are unable to check the details in person, please call the church office. If your name is not in the directory and it should be, please put your information on the correction page.
3. **Updates made in August** - the church database will be updated, and some print copies available the first Sunday in September. If you would prefer to have an e-copy of the directory, please sign the e-copy request log or contact the church office.



Hand In Hand's "What's Your Number?" Fundraiser!

WOW!! We are almost to \$3000 raised We have been so encouraged that we are leaving the board in the foyer for a little while longer! **Don't forget!! If you grabbed envelopes, please bring them back!** Thank you so much to our church family

for your support!

The funds raised will help with the expenses occurred from the flood damage of the CE Centre in March.

So how does this fundraiser work? In the Church foyer are envelopes numbered 1 to 100. If you would like to contribute to this fundraiser, simply take an envelope off the board and donate the dollar value of that envelope. For example - if you take the number 43 you would donate 43 dollars. Do you have a favourite number and was it chosen by someone else? No problem! Simply take two or more envelopes that add up to that number. For example - you want to donate 25 dollars, but the "25" is already gone ... take envelopes "15 and 10" or envelopes "18 and 7" or whatever else adds up to "25". (We are also adding some extra envelopes to the lower numbers of 1 to 10.) If you would like a tax receipt for your donation, add your KUBC envelope number or your name and address to the envelope. Place your envelope in the special box in the foyer on Sundays or in the Office Drop Safe by the window.

We would be so excited to see if all the dollar amounts for the envelopes were donated as all the numbers added together would equal \$5050.00!! (the extra envelopes of the lower numbers are not included in this total)
