JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow meander through Mark)
Read Mark 8:31-33

Messiah Jesus often spoke of himself as the "son of man." He understood that he was this figure in Daniel's vision (Daniel 7:13-14). His disciples were familiar with the term, but the idea of the son of man being rejected, killed and rising again upset them. Peter was sure Jesus had it wrong. "Out of my way!" Jesus barked. He had to contend with ignorance and evil to do the will of God.
