### JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow journey through John)

*Read John 19:10-11*

Pilate is frustrated with this silent Jesus who will neither help himself nor help Pilate do what he hopes to do: wash his hands of the entire mess. Pilate growls "I have the power here! Your life is in *my* hands!" "Any power that you wield is God-given" Jesus replies. "Misuse of power is sin, but the greater sin is that of Caiaphas (and associates) who handed me over to you." (See 18:35)
