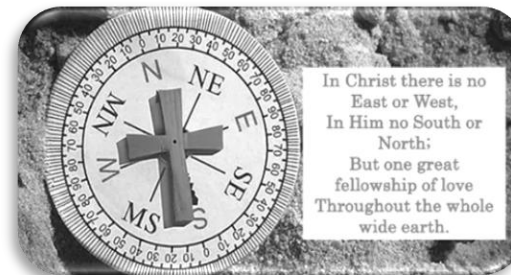

JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow meander through Mark)

Read Mark 6:1-6

Jesus' teaching and miracles amazed the people in his hometown of Nazareth. But this did not lead them to praise God or put their faith in him. Instead, thinking they knew perfectly well who Jesus was—a regular person who'd now become a grandstanding show off—they wrote him off. Jesus exposed this response as prejudiced, ignorant and faithless. He in turn was amazed at them.

Who do I believe Jesus is?
