JUST A THOUGHT . . . (a slow meander through Mark)

Read Mark 9:25-29

Jesus casts the demon out, but not before it gave one last protest. The boy was absolutely spent after his ordeal, but Jesus restores him to full strength. The disciples are puzzled as to why they couldn't cast the demon out for they had been given authority to do so (Mark 3:14-15, 6:12-13).
