Do I ever feel that Jesus is calling me to rest with him? How do I respond?

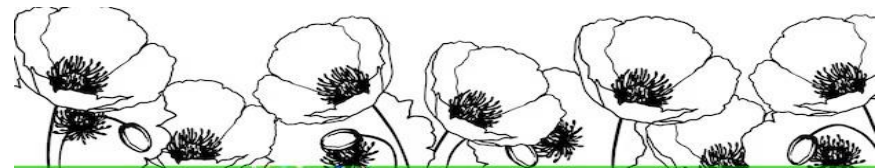

### November 24<sup>th</sup> will be WHITE GIFT SUNDAY

The "White Gift" has traditionally been a special offering here at Kentville Baptist for well over 65 years. The beginning of "White Gift Sunday" has its roots in a small Methodist church in Ohio in 1904 when the minister's wife initiated the idea to solve the problem of inequity of gifts given at the Sunday school Christmas party. The focus shifted from receiving gifts to bringing gifts to Jesus that could be shared around the community. All the gifts would come wrapped in plain white paper so that no one would know which was an expensive gift or a more modest one. What began as a humble way to reflect on the love and devotion of the giver and not the value of the gift has grown into today's white gift donations in many churches across denominations including Baptist churches.

At Kentville Baptist, the White Gift has traditionally been a monetary donation where the funds donated are now used to purchase gift cards which our church will provide to those in need. Each year, our church provides help to approximately 50 families.

If you wish to contribute towards helping others at this time of year, the Board of Community Ministries will provide special "White Gift" envelopes in the bulletin over the next couple of weeks and your gift will be received on Sunday, November 24. If you require a tax receipt for your gift, please write your church envelope number or your name and address on the envelope.

Recipients will be told that delivery to them will be between 9:30 and 10:30. We are suggesting that volunteers also go in pairs.**
